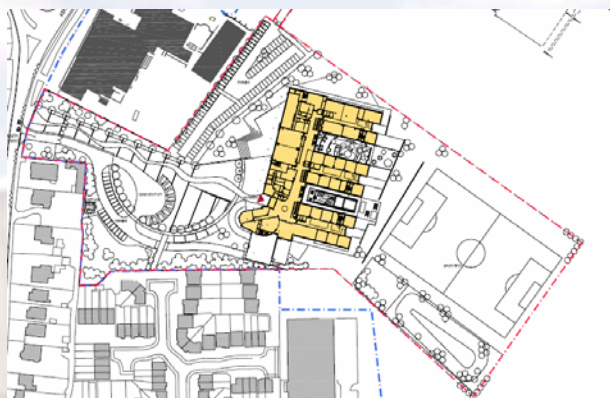




Landau Forte Academy Tamworth – Post 16 Centre

Newsletter – 21st May 2010

Following the granting of planning permission for the new Landau Forte Academy Post 16 Centre. Construction works are due to commence on 24th May 2010.



The new academy buildings will be built on the site of the old all weather pitch. The old weather pitch will be taken out of use from Tuesday 1st June 2010. The new all weather pitch will be complete and available for use from 1st June 2010.

From Monday 24th May 2010 Willmott Dixon will secure the southern car park area, next to the Gungate Hotel, for our site compound. Access to the compound and the new academy site will be via the existing entrance and will be shared with the school.

During this week we shall be carrying out survey works and site investigations but no construction works will commence until 1st June 2010.



From Tuesday 1st June 2010 Willmott Dixon will secure the new academy site by erecting a fence around the whole site. From Monday 7th June 2010 the academy site will be secure and segregated from the existing school.

During the initial weeks Willmott Dixon will share the access with the school until the new academy access is constructed.

During the construction works the pedestrian access via School Walk will be closed.

Construction works will commence on Monday 7th June 2010 with excavations and foundations being progressed.
